Ergonomics

Is your desk large enough for the completion of required tasks?

Ensure there is sufficient space for computer, mouse, keyboard, and other equipment

Is your chair suitable?

Height adjustable, adjustable back rest, back rest is supportive of lower back, feet are flat on the floor when using chair, elbows are at 90 degrees when working at desk, no obstacles under desk that prevent working comfortably

Is your equipment set up appropriately?

Screen is an arm's length from where you are sitting, the top of the screen is at eye level or slightly lower, there is no glare on the screen from windows, hands and wrists are straight when typing.

If a laptop is being used, do you have a laptop stand, external mouse, and external keyboard?
